Line Locator

Summary

The Line Locator is responsible for ensuring all Solaris assets are identified and protected against external mechanical damage during ground disturbance activities and that all Solaris assets are properly identified with above ground markers according to the national color code. **This position can be based in Midland, TX or Carlsbad, NM.**

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Oversee timely updates of changes in our system to all relative 811 centers including but not limited to, centerlines, buffer zones and pipeline additions.
- Accurate and organized documentation of work including Texas 811 One-Calls, line locating, and reports concerning volume and timeliness of locates to supervisor
- Lead and oversee all aspects of development, implementation, and ongoing support of the Damage Prevention program and staff.
- Follow all company, client, state, and federal damage prevention program guidelines.
- Using locating equipment to determine location of utilities, mark area with paint and/or flags to prevent damage to utility infrastructure.
- Communicate pipeline protection standards and practices to employees and third parties.
- Provide site inspection of activities occurring on or near the Solaris Right-Of-Way (ROW) to ensure compliance with, and provide enforcement of, Solaris Water Midstream protection zones and ROW excavation conditions.
- Conduct Damage Prevention activities including pipeline patrols, one-calls, locating and marking pipelines, and inspecting line crossings, excavations, and other activities affecting the pipeline.

Skills & Experience

- High school diploma, GED, or equivalent.
- At least 2 years of relevant work experience
- Ability to work with Texas/NM 811 One-Calls and respond appropriately adhering to company policies and state law
- Ability to understand excavation best practices, OSHA regulations, and Managing Safe Work
- Ability to read and interpret alignment sheets, KMZ's and plat maps to facilitate locating lines
- Candidate must possess knowledge of Microsoft Office Applications
- Must be a self-starter and possess the ability to work independently
